

Dear customer, carrier and supplier

Notice about sharpened safety requirements with Fortum - also for carriers.

At Fortum Waste Solutions, we have increased focus on safety and health. We strive in our daily work to avoid accidents for all employees (external as well as internal) during work at Fortum. We have a clear target to have zero accidents and thus ask you to consider that as a customer. It is your responsibility that drivers transporting waste and auxiliary substances to Fortum know and comply with our safety rules.

From 1 April, 2021, we initiate the following sharpened safety requirements for drivers who deliver waste and auxiliary substances to Fortum.

- Requirement as to safety training
- Increased admittance control
- Sharpened requirement as to use of personal protection equipment

Access control at Fortum, Nyborg

To increase safety, we implement admittance control for drivers as per 1 April, 2021. All drivers must present a personal Access Card when being at Fortum's area. The personal Access Card is handed out by our gate personnel when presenting documents in relation to waste, and after unloading, the drivers give the card back to the gate personnel.

Safety training

The safety training can be conducted in advance. It must be conducted online and it takes approx. 30 minutes - you will get access to the training via the link <https://www.elearning.fi/fortum/denmark.html>. The training must be conducted every 2. year. You have to print the certificate after your training and show it at our gate at every arrival.

Personal protection equipment

Our requirements for drivers delivering waste and auxiliary substances will be exactly the same as for own employees working at the plant. The drivers must wear:

- Fire-resistant work clothes with long sleeves and long trousers - it should as a minimum comply with EN ISO 11612 (A1, B1, C1) standard (or analogous).
- Hi-Vis work clothes - it should as a minimum comply with EN ISO 20471 class 2 (or analogous).
