

# Our rules – your safety!

## Drivers

You **always** have to wear the following personal protection equipment and access card outside the safety corridor. It is, however, allowed to wait and put on the fire-resistant work clothes when you start to unload, but you always must wear all-covering clothes and other personal protection equipment when you leave your car.

All protection equipment must be CE approved

 <p><b>Helmet with chin strap</b> EN 397</p>		
 <p><b>Safety glasses or face shield</b> EN 166</p>		
 <p><b>Fortum ID</b> Will be handed out at our gate and it must be visible</p>		
 <p><b>Gloves</b> Minimum EN 420, , however adapted to the job</p>		
<p><b>Hi-Vis</b> EN ISO 20471 class 2</p>		
 <p><b>Fire-resistant clothes</b> EN ISO 11612</p> <p><b>all-covering clothes</b> Long trousers and shirts/jackets with long sleeves and socks covering your ankles</p>		
 <p><b>Safety shoes,</b> EN ISO 20345</p>		

All drivers must have conducted the safety training as from 1 April, 2021 to get admittance to our area. You have to present the documentation for having completed the safety training to our gate staff before you get the Fortum ID handed out. When you leave our plant, you hand the Fortum ID to the gate staff.
